
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
Evidence2Practice Ontario (E2P) Tool Installation Guide

A. Import the Custom Forms

 In PS Suite EMR, from the Records window, choose Settings > Edit Custom Forms.



 In the Forms window, from the File menu, choose Import Form(s).



- 3. Navigate to your **computer's desktop** and double-click the folder that contains the custom form files.
- 4. Click the custom form(s) in the list that you want to import.
- Click the **Choose** button. If you are importing multiple forms at once, and depending on the speed of your computer, the import may take 30 seconds or more.
 A message will prompt you when the import is successful.



Optional Toolbar Customization

By default, the tools open as 'pop-up' windows. Selecting and saving this checkbox will default the launching of tools directly into the progress notes section.




2. In the search

Click "Edit Form".

In the pop-up window, choose Basic Editor.





Select the box "Enable toolbar buttons to insert tools directly into patient chart"


Click "Checked" in the box on the right.






B. Import Flowsheet

 In PS Suite EMR, from the Records window, choose View > Show Flowsheet.



 Click File > click Utilities > then choose Import Flowsheet Template.




- 8. Navigate to your **computer's desktop** and double-click the folder that contains the flowsheet files.
- 9. Click the **flowsheet(s)** in the list that you want to import. The flowsheets will be ".flowsheet" files.
- 10. Click the **Choose** button. The import may take 30 seconds or more. A message will prompt you when the import is successful.




C. Set Up Reminders

window, choose

Reminders.




Click New Reminder at the bottom.




13. Enter "E2P

Line.






D. New Tool Version Process

After you have downloaded the updated tool package, follow these steps to <u>import the tool</u> into the EMR.

Before using the updated Heart Failure Management Tool, you must complete the form customizations and localization settings for certain features to work.






To customize the SOAP note stamp to a different stamp follow these instructions.

If you would like to use the default stamp developed by E2P, please skip this step.

1. Click on the **custom stamp** box.

In the window on the right, scroll down to the line for "Checked".

Then click on the box next to it to check it off.



2. Stamp name


 Click on the corresponding blank box.

window:


 Scroll down to the Stamps list and search for the stamp you would like to embed.

Then on the **bottom right** half of the window:


- Scroll down to the line for "Text".
- Then enter the name of the stamp you wish to add.





C. Known Issues/Errors

1. Rendering custom form issues:

Problem: All sites will experience the form overlapping issue on the first opening of the tools after installation/update.

Solution: Unfortunately, this is a known PS Suite error. Open each E2P form and if this issue is seen, close the window and re-open. Please note that this will only happen once, you will not encounter this for each patient.



2. Tool Installation Troubleshooting:

Problem: Some users have experienced an error message during installation resulting in a cancelled installation with no forms being imported. This is most often seen when importing the "E2P – MH – Anxiety Disorders and Depression Visit Tool". We believe this may occur due to the EMRs temporary files folder being full, the file size of the forms, and the long file path of forms.

Troubleshooting:


1. Try importing forms in smaller batches (5 or less has been found to be helpful)



- 2. Do not import the largest files together or import the largest files individually (i.e. separate the installation of the Inlow's and 'E2P MH Anxiety Disorders and Depression Visit Tool').
- 3. Logging out and back in of the EMR can sometimes help clear the temp folder and fix installation
- 4. Try placing the folder temporarily on your desktop before installing to reduce the file path.
